On 15 May 2003 she was elected President of the Official Order of Architects of Galicia, being the first woman in this position.

In April 2005 she codirected the Social Housing work requested by the Architecture and Society Thematic Area of the Architects' Council of Europe about the housing reality in the European Union.

From August 2005 to April 2009, she took up the post of Regional Minister for Housing in Galicia

From May 2009 to February 2012, she was a Member of the Galician Parliament.



At present, she combines the presidency of the company TF2L Infraestructuras S.A with her professional activity as an architect, with several projects underway, among which we must highlight the rehabilitation of the 12th century Monastery of San Paio de Abeleda-Ourense for a 5 star hotel.
